POLICY STATEMENT

P.2.19 Accessibility Planning

Rainbow District School Board is committed to making services and facilities accessible to people in our communities in accordance with the provisions of the *Human Rights Code*, the *Ontarians with Disabilities Act* and the *Ontario Building Code*.

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

OP.2.19 Accessibility Planning

The Board will establish a committee comprised of trustees, staff representatives and a representative from the School Council Coordinating Committee.

The committee will ensure that each year, input is solicited on the identification of barriers from a variety of stakeholders including but not limited to staff, parents, and students.

The committee will develop an accessibility plan on an annual basis that will identify barriers to access facilities and services.

The plan will target specific barriers for removal in that year. The plan shall be presented to the Board for approval subject to available resources.

The Board will ensure that the plan is made available to the public.
