POLICY STATEMENT

P.3.10 CO-INSTRUCTIONAL ACTIVITIES

THE BOARD BELIEVES THAT CO- INSTRUCTIONAL ACTIVITIES FORM AN INTEGRAL PART OF A STUDENT’S EDUCATION AND SUPPORTS COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS IN THE DELIVERY OF ITS CO-INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM.

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

OP.3.10 Co-instructional activities means activities other than providing instruction that, support the operation of schools, enrich a pupil’s school-related experience whether within or beyond the instructional program, and advance pupils’ education and education-related goals.

1. Principals may recruit volunteers from the community using newsletters, advertisements in the local media, and/or the Board’s electronic communications systems.
2. Community volunteers must submit a criminal background check and a completed Volunteer Information Form. Criminal Background Checks and Volunteer Information Forms will be maintained by the school. The cost of a criminal check will be assumed by the school.
3. School Principals will:
 - review criminal background checks
 - review and sign Volunteer Information Forms
 - designate teacher contacts
 - ensure volunteers receive appropriate training
4. Co-Instructional community volunteers will follow the rules, regulations and schedules for all activities under the jurisdiction of the Sudbury District Secondary Schools Athletic Association or the North Shore Secondary School Athletic Association.
