### **Substitution Reminder for Coaches**

**The NOSSA coed playing regulations state:**

**SUBSTITUTION:** Unlimited substitution at the conclusion of a game shall be allowed; otherwise stated as per CCA rules for junior men and ladies.

Based on this we defer to the CCA's Rules of Curling for General Play.

**5. Teams**

- (1) **Every team shall be comprised of a minimum of four players** as determined by the rules of the competition except as provided for in Rule 5(5). Prior to each game, the team shall designate the four eligible members of the team who will commence play as players for that team.

**OFSAA Rules states:**

**7. Rules and Officials**

**(a) Substitution:**

The host Association shall be responsible for providing a pool of curlers available for substitution .

- (1) During the competition, if a team has only four (4) players and one player is unable to continue play because of illness or injury, they must select randomly from the host pool of curlers and that player shall play lead; if the original player is able to play again he/she may re-enter the competition at the beginning of a game.

We as convener will be providing a pool of curlers who will be available for substitution in the event of injury or illness after the start of competition.

## Playing Regulations Canadian Curling Association

A copy of the CCA Rules of Curling for General Play 2007/2008 is available if you would like to view it. The Curlers' Code of Ethics, the Coaching Code of Ethics and Fair Play are on page three of this document. Each coach is to ensure his or her team understands, embraces, and follows these guidelines in addition to all guidelines in our NOSSA Constitution, By-laws, Playing Regulations and the OFSAA Code of Conduct.

**OFFICIALS:** Will be provided for all rounds of play. Coaches will be made aware of who the officials are. Please wait for officials prior to going to the ice surface for a time out.

**SUBSTITUTION:** Unlimited substitution at the conclusion of a game shall be allowed: otherwise as per CCA rules for Junior Men and Women.

**EXTRA ENDS:** Will be added to break any ties after eight ends. A time out will be granted to each team prior to the ninth end.

**FOURTH END BREAK:** Will be two minutes in length after the fourth end, during which the coach may access the ice surface to discuss strategy with the team. The teams must not leave the ice surface during this break.

**TIME OUTS:** Each team will be allowed two, one-minute time outs at any point during the game when rock is within possession (Coaches please do not tap on the glass to gain the attention of your team.)

**FREE GUARD ZONE:** The CCA rules regarding "Free Guard Zone" will be in effect for both Boys' and Girls' playdowns.

**CONSOLATION DRAW:** involving teams knocked out of the Championship draw in rounds one and two will be played if there is time and facilities are available.

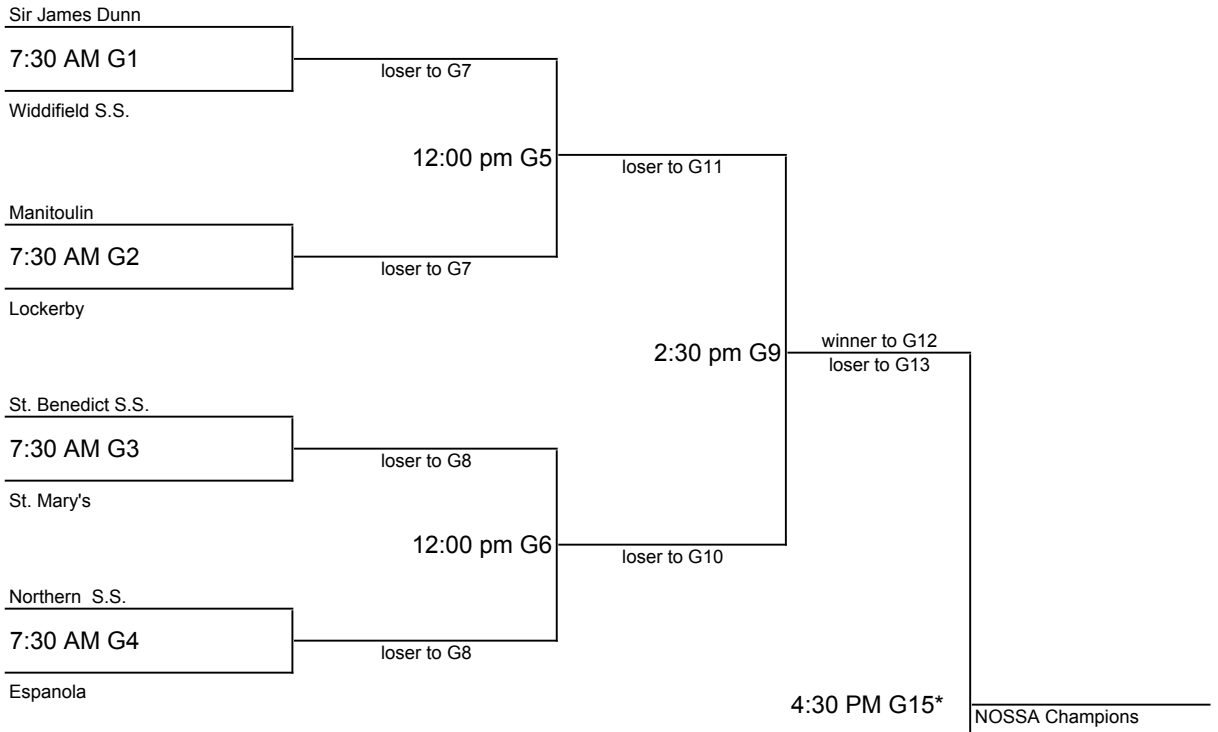
**TOUCHED DELIVERED STONE OR STONE(S) SET IN MOTION:** A delivered stone, or stone set in motion shall not be touched by any player, equipment or personal belongings of the team to which it belongs.

(1. Allow play to stand 2. Traditional resolve technique)

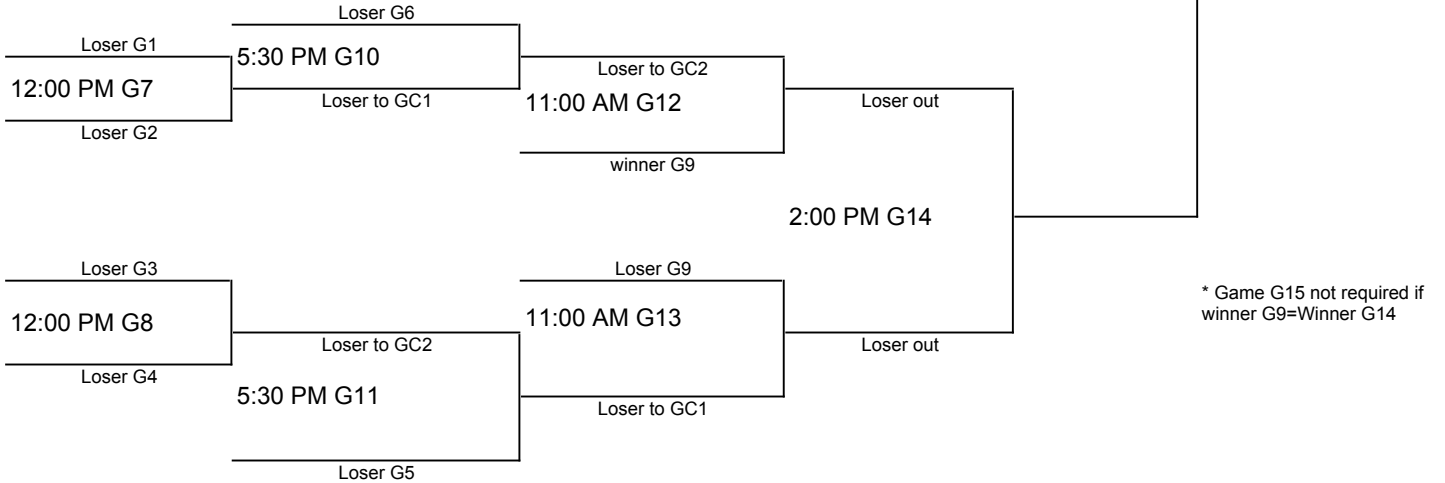
