Admission Requirements:

Students who wish to participate must:

- Be at least 16 years of age
- Have acquired 16 credits or more towards an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)
- Have a Social Insurance Number
- Pass an initial interview with a Co-op teacher followed by an interview with Cambrian College

Description:

New initiative aimed at grade 12 students

- Apprenticeship training for students interested in HDET trade
- Consists of Level One In-School Training at Cambrian College and a work experience placement in industry
- Be enrolled in the OYAP option of Co-operative Education

Benefits:

While completing an OSSD, participating students will:

- Complete Level One of the In-School component for the HDET trade
- Earn one Co-operative Education credit and two transportation technology credits TTJ
- Register as an apprentice in HDET
- Acquire practical experience and knowledge in the HDET trade



Mandatory Safety Equipment:

- 8" safety boots, CSA green patch approved
- Safety glasses
- Coveralls
- Mechanics gloves

Passing Grade:

70% is required for the In-School Level One Training

Tools:

Tools will be provided by Cambrian College for use on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays

Attendance:

Full attendance is **mandatory** in Level One In-School Training
