As directed by Public Health, the Consortium **CANCELS** bus runs when there is a confirmed case of COVID-19. Drivers of affected runs are required to self-isolate for their entire route. If there is no driver for the other runs on the route, the entire route may be cancelled. Health and safety is our first and foremost priority.



A case of COVID-19 on a school bus results in the cancellation of the morning and afternoon runs. Two drivers may be required to self-isolate. If there are transfers on the affected run, more drivers could be required to self-isolate.



There are not a lot of extra bus drivers. As a result, all runs on the route may have to be cancelled. Given that local school boards share bus routes, students in a number of schools may be affected.



Parents must notify the Consortium when transportation is no longer needed. Otherwise, your child's name will be on the list of students required to self-isolate due to a confirmed case of COVID-19.



When you want to resume transportation for your child, contact the Consortium. Students can be reassigned to a school bus within two days.



All Kindergarten to Grade 12 students are required to wear a face mask on the school bus at all times. Please ensure the mask fits properly. It must cover the mouth and the nose.



When a bus run is cancelled due to COVID-19, the Consortium will email a letter from Public Health to affected parents. Parents will also receive an automated phone call. Please ensure the Consortium has your current phone number and email address.
