RE: COVID-19 OUTBREAK AT CONFEDERATION SECONDARY SCHOOL ALL STUDENTS AND STAFF TO SELF-ISOLATE TO AND INCLUDING MARCH 26

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Public Health Sudbury & Districts has declared an outbreak at Confederation Secondary School after a fourth individual tested positive for COVID-19.

With evidence of widespread transmission at Confederation Secondary School, Public Health has directed that ALL staff and students must self-isolate to and including March 26, 2021 and be tested for COVID-19. Please follow the guidance from Public Health.

As per provincial direction, a school outbreak is declared if there are two or more cases in a school that are linked and if there is evidence that at least one case could have been infected in the school. The entire school is dismissed when there is evidence of widespread transmission.

Students will continue to learn remotely until further notice.
