## RE: R.L. BEATTIE STUDENTS ON ONE BUS RUN REQUIRED TO SELF-ISOLATE

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Public Health Sudbury & Districts advised the Sudbury Student Services Consortium that students from R.L. Beattie Public School **on one bus run** are required to self-isolate. This is due to a possible exposure to COVID-19 related to the Grade 6 class in Room 200 that was dismissed earlier this week. A third student subsequently tested positive for COVID-19 while at home self-isolating.

By direction of Public Health, students on the morning run on bus Route L819 have been asked to self-isolate. The affected students, their parents/guardians and relevant bus driver have been notified and have received a letter from Public Health with guidance.

## R.L. Beattie Public School remains open for in-person learning.

The school will follow up with affected students to ensure continuity of learning.

For students and staff who have not been asked to self-isolate as part of this confirmed case, the following applies:

- Simply passing by an infected person in the hallway is not considered close contact, and the risk of spreading the virus this way is extremely low.
- Remember to screen for COVID-19 daily. Continue to use the **COVID-19 Screening Tool** for **Children in School and Child Care** <a href="https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/">https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/</a> to monitor for symptoms and follow the direction provided. **Anyone who is sick must stay home**.

Remember to follow the critical ongoing COVID-19 prevention measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- · Sneeze and cough into your sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Stay home and isolate if symptoms appear.
- · Practise two-metre physical distancing.
- Wear a mask at all times in indoor public spaces.

When outdoors, students are encouraged to maintain physical distancing.

We are monitoring our school population closely for any signs of COVID-19 and following the guidance from Public Health.
