RE: CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19 AT LASALLE SECONDARY SCHOOL

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Public Health Sudbury & Districts has advised Rainbow District School Board that a confirmed case of COVID-19 has been reported at Lasalle Secondary School.

The individual is currently self-isolating and being monitored by Public Health Sudbury & Districts. There is no evidence of transmission of COVID-19 at the school at this time. Lasalle Secondary School remains open for in-person learning.

In an abundance of caution, by direction of Public Health, staff and students in the Grade 8 class in Room 217 have been asked to self-isolate, regardless of vaccination status. The affected students, their parents/guardians and relevant staff have been notified and have received a letter from Public Health with specific guidance. Public Health will reach out to all affected parents/guardians and staff with additional detailed instructions once their initial investigation is complete.

The school will follow up with affected students to ensure continuity of learning.

As a precaution, Lasalle Secondary School is being cleaned and disinfected overnight.

For students and staff who have not been asked to self-isolate as part of this confirmed case, the following applies:

• Simply passing by an infected person in the hallway is not considered close contact, and the risk of spreading the virus this way is extremely low.

• Remember to screen for COVID-19 daily. Continue to use the **COVID-19 Screening Tool** for Children in School and Child Care <u>https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/</u> to monitor for symptoms and follow the direction provided. Anyone who is sick must stay home.

Remember to follow the critical ongoing COVID-19 prevention measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Sneeze and cough into your sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Stay home and *isolate* if symptoms appear.
- Practise two-metre physical distancing.
- Wear a mask at all times in indoor public spaces.

When outdoors, students are encouraged to maintain physical distancing.
