RE: FIVE CONFIRMED CASES OF COVID-19 AT LANSDOWNE PUBLIC SCHOOL

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Public Health Sudbury & Districts has advised Rainbow District School Board that five confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported at Lansdowne Public School.

The individuals are currently self-isolating and being monitored by Public Health Sudbury & Districts. The school will be cleaned and disinfected this weekend. **There is no evidence of transmission at the school at this time.**

Lansdowne Public School remains open for in-person learning. The school will follow up with affected students to ensure continuity of learning.

Childcare and the before and after school program are not affected.

By direction of Public Health, students in the following classes have been asked to self-isolate to and including October 15, 2021 - Grade K/1 FI - Room 104, Grade 1 FI - Class (1/2/3 French Immersion) Room 005, and Grade 5/6 ENG Room 204. The affected students, their parents/guardians and relevant staff have been notified and have received a letter from Public Health with specific guidance. Direction for staff is based on immunization status.

By direction of Public Health, students on the following bus runs have also been asked to self-isolate to and including October 15, 2021 – elementary run on morning Route N126, elementary run on afternoon Route N126 and elementary run on afternoon route L011. These routes are cancelled and will resume on Monday, October 18, 2021. The affected students, their parents/guardians and relevant drivers have been notified and have received a letter from Public Health with specific guidance.

For students and staff who have not been asked to self-isolate as part of this confirmed case, the following applies:

• Simply passing by an infected person in the hallway is not considered close contact, and the risk of spreading the virus this way is extremely low.

• Remember to screen for COVID-19 daily. Continue to use the **COVID-19 Screening Tool** for Children in School and Child Care <u>https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/</u> to monitor for symptoms and follow the direction provided. Anyone who is sick must stay home.

Remember to follow the critical ongoing COVID-19 prevention measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Sneeze and cough into your sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Stay home and isolate if symptoms appear.
- Practise two-metre physical distancing.

• Wear a mask at all times in indoor public spaces.

When outdoors, students are encouraged to maintain physical distancing.

We continue to work closely with Public Health as we implement ongoing health and safety protocols to limit the spread of COVID-19.

We will monitor our school population closely for any signs of COVID-19 and follow the guidance from Public Health.

Public Health continues to investigate the situation and if any risks to the school community are identified, they may direct additional measures.
