RE: PUBLIC HEALTH DECLARES OUTBREAK AT ADAMSDALE PUBLIC SCHOOL

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Public Health Sudbury & Districts has declared a COVID-19 outbreak at Adamsdale Public School based on the confirmed cases that have already been reported.

An outbreak in a school is defined as **two** or more lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases in students or staff (or other visitors) in a school where at least one case could have reasonably acquired their infection in the school.

Public Health continues to investigate the situation and if any further risks to the school community are identified, they may direct additional measures.

Adamsdale Public School remains open for in-person learning.

The school will follow up with affected students to ensure continuity of learning.

For students and staff who have not been asked to self-isolate as part of this outbreak, the following applies:

- Simply passing by an infected person in the hallway is not considered close contact, and the risk of spreading the virus this way is extremely low.
- Remember to screen for COVID-19 daily. Continue to use the **COVID-19 Screening Tool for Children in School and Child Care** <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/> to monitor for symptoms and follow the direction provided. **Stay home and seek testing at the first sign of a COVID-19 symptom, even a mild one.**

Remember to follow the critical ongoing COVID-19 prevention measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Sneeze and cough into your sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Stay home and [isolate](#) if symptoms appear.
- Practise two-metre physical distancing.
- **Wear a mask** at all times in indoor public spaces.
