Mental Health Strategy

Dr. Amber Perry, Chief Psychologist and Mental Health Lead and Social Worker Christine McInnes provided a detailed presentation highlighting the events in the day of a social worker in a Rainbow school. Stories were shared about how the four social workers assist school staff in promoting school based mental health models and interventions.

Trustees were able to ask questions and make comments about the role of social workers in schools. Trustees noted the many responses they have received thanking for social worker support in both elementary and secondary schools. There is a need for this support.
