




To depict why our school is growing and to show how our community is growing as a whole.



How Did We Get Here?


- 4-Laning of Hwy 69 is making the travel time shorter to Sudbury

Lebert Family


- Relocated to Northern Ontario for work

- Improved family life more family time less go-go city life attitude






Renouf Family

- 3 children







Barrett Family

Wouldn't you want to live here?






Proposed Action
