

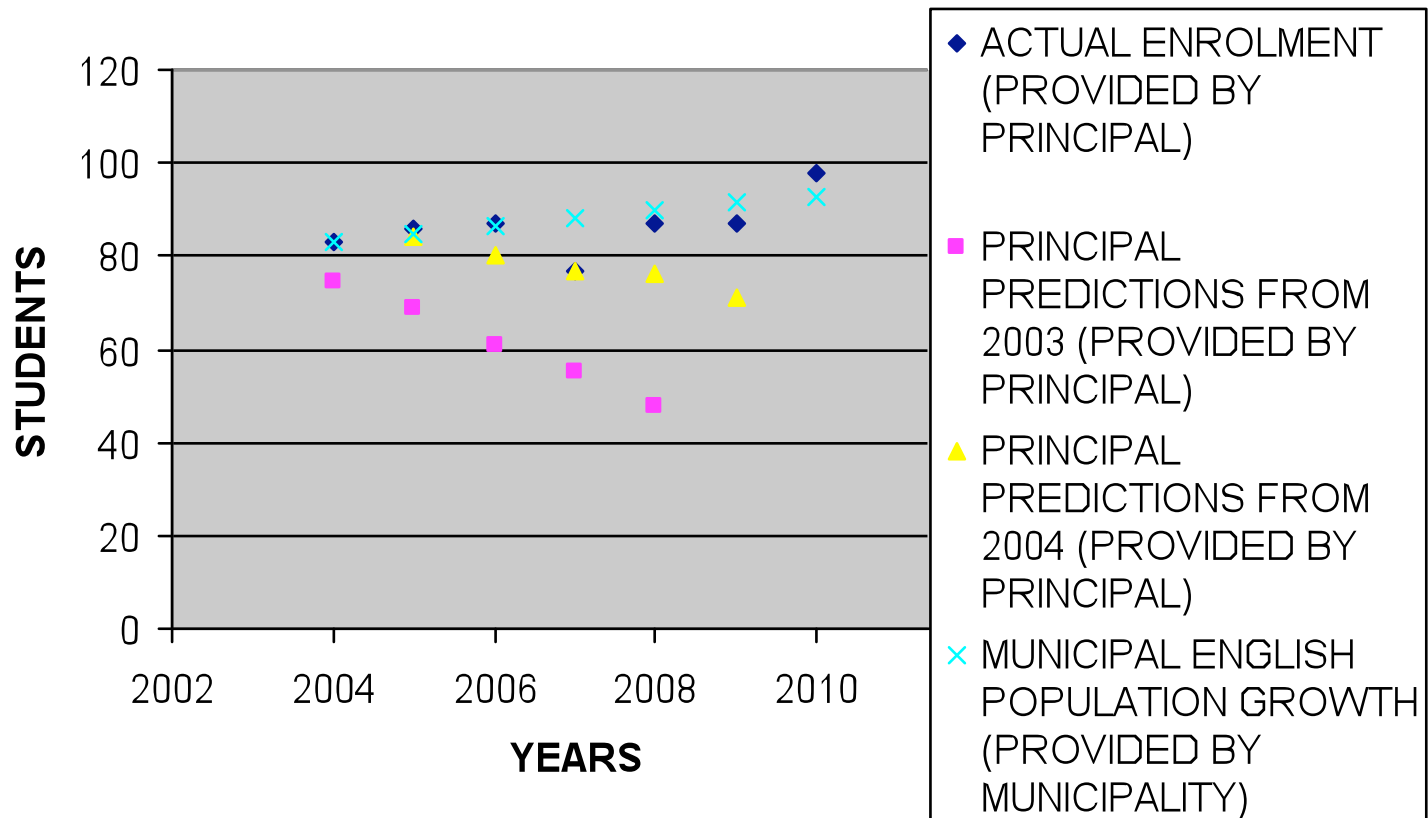




Goals of Presentation



-

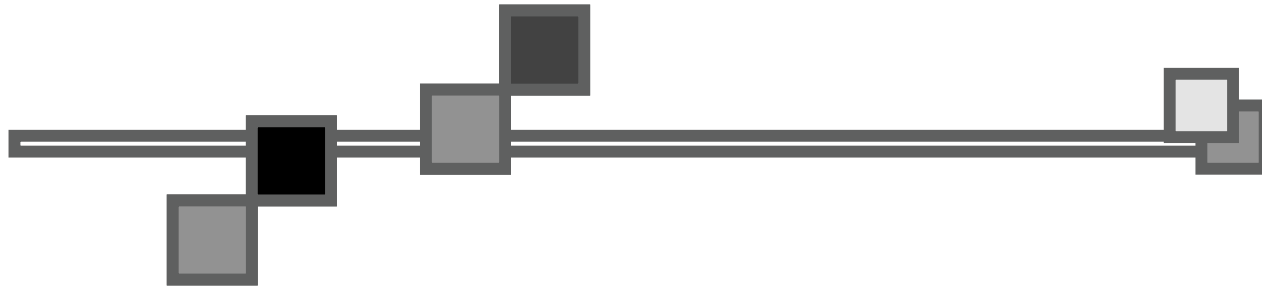
MONETVILLE ACTUAL AND PREDICTED ENROLLMENT VS. MUNICIPAL ENGLISH POPULATION GROWTH



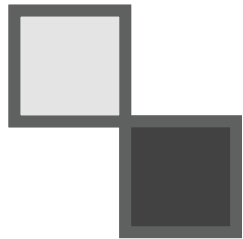


How Did We Get Here?

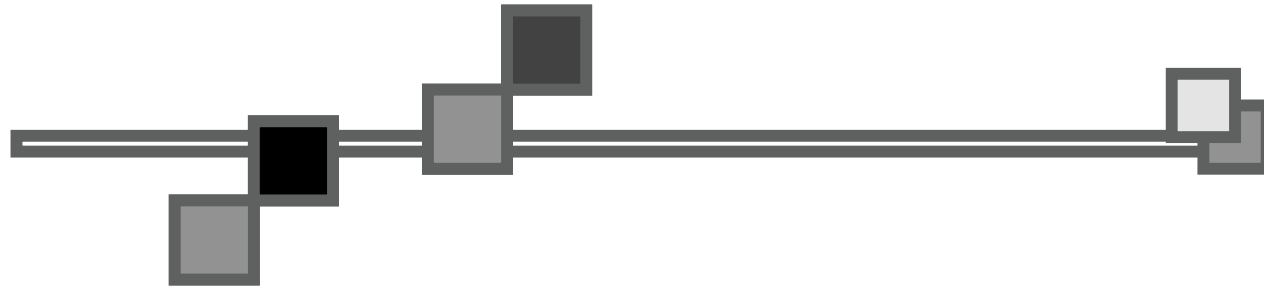


Lebert Family

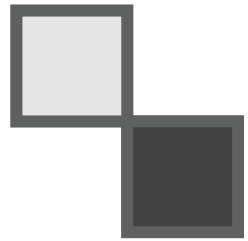


- Relocated to Northern Ontario for work

- Community – everyone knows your name



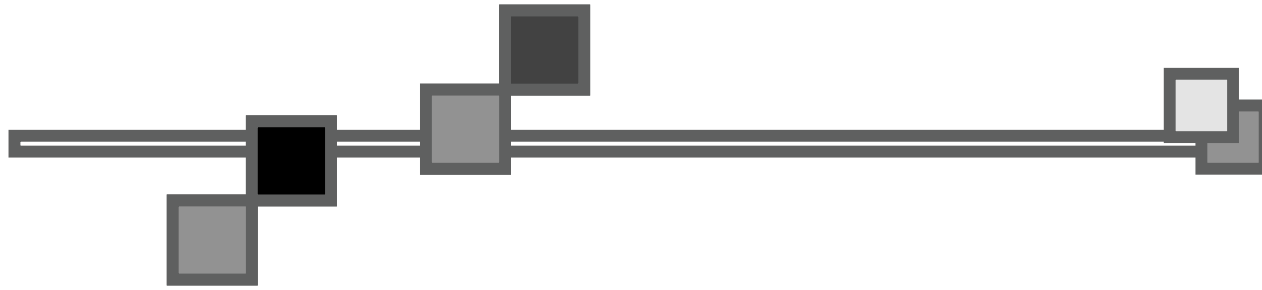


Cuff Family

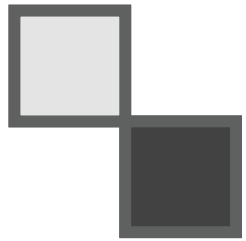


- Moved to French River from Guelph area

- Improved family life – more family time – less go-go city life attitude



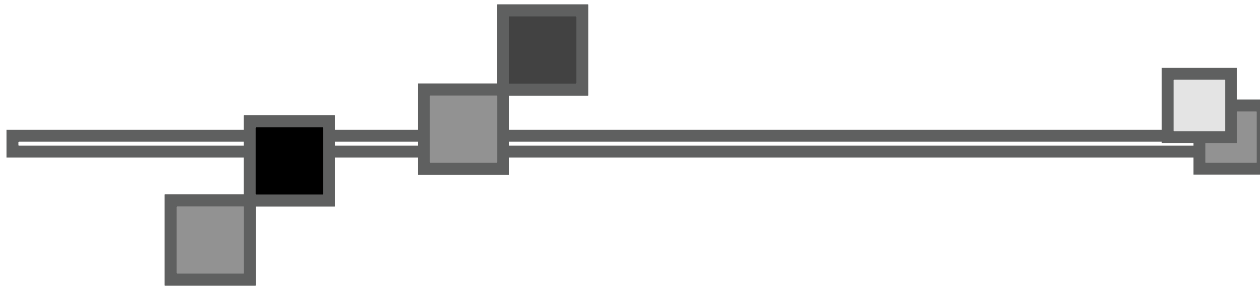


Renouf Family

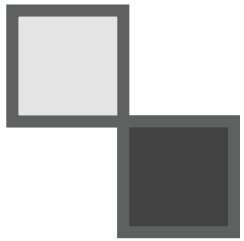


- Wanted rural setting – wildlife, boating...

- Helpful neighbours at a time of need





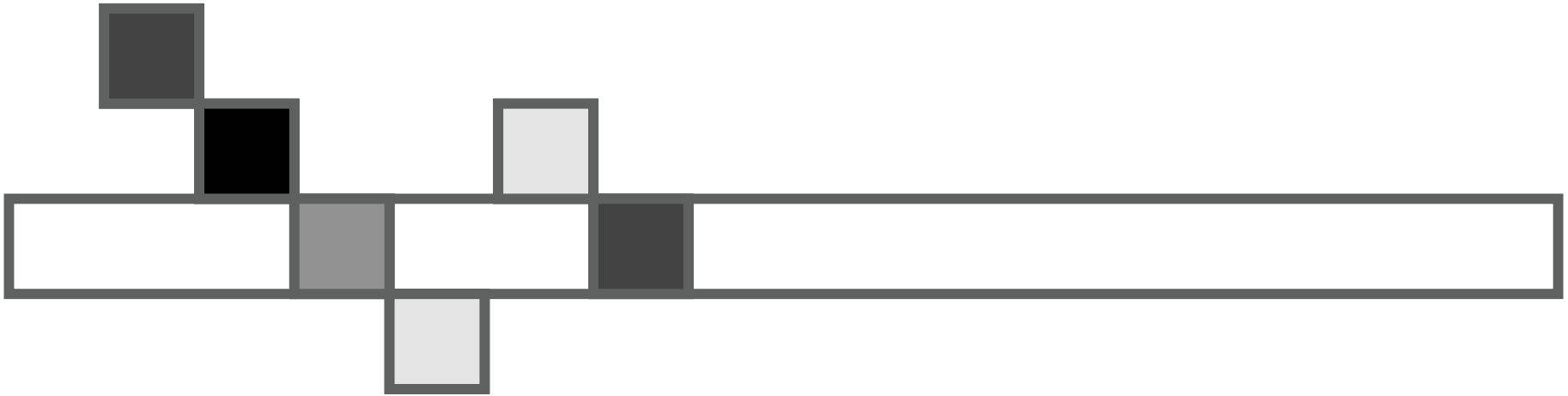
