## Graduation

### Ontario Secondary School Diploma OSSD

- ◆ 30 credits in Academic, Applied, Open, Locally Developed Compulsory Courses (Essentials) (18 compulsory, 12 optional); successful completion of the Ontario School Literacy Test (OSSLT) or the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course (OSSLC); completion of 40 hours of community involvement

### Ontario Secondary School Certificate OSSC

- ◆ 14 credits in Academic, Applied, Open, Locally Developed Compulsory Courses (Essentials), (7 compulsory, 7 optional)

### Certificate of Accomplishment

- ◆ 30 Non-credit (K) course completions; combination of 30 Non-credit course completions and credits
