This program aims to provide every child with the supports he or she needs in order to develop independence, confidence and competence in learning, a sense of security, and respect for diversity.

What's NEW?

- Each classroom has 26 children, a teacher and an early childhood educator and the option of a before and after school program, for a fee.
- Learning happens throughout the day and through play and inquiry.
- Learning activities are designed as problems to be solved.
- Children are active in their learning—exploring, investigating, creating, composing, pretending, and communicating.
- Children becoming increasingly more responsibility for themselves, others and the classroom space.
- Teachers and early childhood educators intentionally design the learning environment (including the space and the materials) and the pose questions that lead children to the formal skills math, science, reading, writing, the arts.
