Literacy Happens Everywhere!

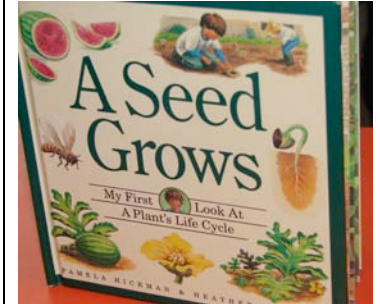
- Children sing songs, say rhymes and poems, and play with sounds.
- Teachers and Early Childhood Educators read a variety of books to children daily.
- Children use books to find answers to their questions and children record what they observe as drawings, diagrams, maps, words or sentences at learning centres.
- Adults record children's ideas so children can read and re-read them
- Children learn reading strategies in small groups.
- Reading and writing occurs during the day and continues in the before and after school programs.
- The questions children ask are starting points for learning to read & write.

Young children listen, read, write and view texts in order to make sense of their world.

By having literacy materials everywhere, children learn to see reading and writing as part of their every day lives.
