This week's math game continues to build on "subitizing" skills. Through the use of the domino cards children start to recognize that quantities to ten, can be represented by different configurations of dots.

Dot Card War

What you'll need:

- Two sets of Domino cards

How to play:

- Play in groups of 2.
- The domino cards are shuffled and dealt out to each player.
- Each player turns over a card.
- The player with the highest number takes both cards and adds them to the bottom of his pile.
- If a tie is the result, then the next card is turned over and the player with the highest number takes them all.
- Play continues until one player remains without cards.
