

Hide and Peek

Materials:

Five snap cubes of one colour and five snap cubes of another colour.

How to Play:

Snap the cubes together in a tower of ten so that all of one colour are together and all of the other colour are together. Player one snaps off some of the cubes and hides them behind their back. Player two looks at the remaining cubes and tries to guess how many are hiding. Player one reveals the hidden cubes. The players indicate the number combination (e.g., 3 cubes and 7 cubes makes 10 cubes).

Variation: The game can be played with fewer cubes in total, however five cubes of one colour should always be snapped together (e.g. if you are playing Hide and Peak with 8, snap together 5 cubes of one colour and then attach 3 cubes of a second colour).

Variation: Player one places some cubes on the table and separates the remaining cubes into two hands behind their back. Player one asks player two to pick a hand. Player two then determines how many cubes are still hiding.
