

Part Whole Bingo

Materials:

Part Whole Bingo Game Boards

Part Whole Bingo Spinners


Paper Clip and pencil

Counters (e.g., pennies, small Lego pieces)


How to Play:

Player one spins the spinner two times and finds the total of their two spins. This total is the number of counters that can be placed on the game board. The counters can be placed all together on one column or they can be shared between columns, however, a column must be completely covered (e.g., if a player spins a total of 6, they can completely fill a column with 4 spaces available and a column with 2 spaces available). Players work cooperatively to cover all the columns on their game boards.
