Four Strikes


(single digit)

Materials:

Paper Pencil Counters (e.g., pennies, small Lego pieces)

How to Play:

Player one records a number sentence on their page without showing player two (e.g., 5 + 7 = 12). A gameboard is created as below:



0123456789

Player two selects one digit at a time to try to complete the number sentence. Player one records correct guesses on the lines and draws a line through incorrect digits. Player two tries to complete the number sentence before making four incorrect guesses.

Variation: Players can vary the structure of the number sentence (e.g., _ = _ + _ ; _ _ - _ = _).

Variation: Play the game with more or fewer strikes.

Variation: Play the game with two digit numbers.
