Decimal Golf

Materials:

Two dice
Decimal Golf Game Board
10x10 Grid

How to Play:

Players take turns rolling two dice and using the digits to create a two-digit number that includes a decimal number (e.g., if a player rolls 2 and 5, a player could create 0.25, 0.52, 2.5 or 5.2).

Players record the number in the appropriate section of the score card and use the 10x10 grid to determine which player recorded the number that is closest to par (see gameboard). The player with the closest number circles their score. Play continues until players have completed all nine holes. The player who has the most circled numbers is the winner.
