TRESPASS

1. PURPOSE

It is the goal of Rainbow District School Board, as mandated under the Education Act and Regulations and by the Ministry of Education, that all working and learning environments be safe and caring for students, staff and the general public.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

Occupier: Under the Trespass to Property Act, the "occupier" refers to: "a person who has responsibility for and control over the condition of premises or the activities there carried on, or control over persons allowed to enter the premises".

3. APPLICATION

This Administrative Procedure applies to all students, staff and the general public who access Rainbow District School Board facilities and board/school events.

PROCEDURES

- 1. A Prohibition of Entry order may be issued by the "occupier" under the Trespass to Property Act if a person(s):
 - (a) engage(s) in a prohibited activity on Rainbow District School Board property or at a school or board related event
 - (b) presence is detrimental to the safety or well-being of others.
- 2. Prohibited activity includes but is not limited to any activity that does not comply with the standards of behavior under the Rainbow District School Board Code of Conduct.
- 3. Person(s) banned under the Notice of Prohibition of Entry may be reinstated upon providing the following written documentation:
 - 3.1 Acknowledgement to the "occupier" that his or her behavior did not comply with the standards of behavior under the Rainbow District School Board Code of Conduct.
 - 3.2 Acknowledgement that he or she has read and agrees to comply with Rainbow District School Board's Code of Conduct in all future dealings with persons governed by the Code of Conduct on all or part of Rainbow District School Board property.

4. The occupier shall forward all *Prohibition of Entry* orders to the Executive Assistant to the Director of Education for the Rainbow District School Board.
