#### **Definitions**

ADE - Average Daily Enrolment - October 31st enrolment x .5 + March 31st enrolment x .5

ASD - Autism Spectrum Disorder

**FCI** - Facilities Condition Index - 5 Year Renewal Requirements / Replacement Cost of an Asset Renewal Requirements in a Given Year = (Current Year Renewal + Backlog)

FTE - Full Time Equivalent

**GFA** - Gross Floor Area - The total floor area of a building including: instructional areas, operational areas, corridors, hallways, entrances, entry vestibules, stairs, refuge areas, and external wall thickness.

**IB** - International Baccalaureate Program - This internationally recognized two-year comprehensive program encourages critical thinking and research skills and promotes service as part of the learning process.

**ISP** - Intensive Support Program

Intramural Sports - Recreational sports organized within a school.

**OTG** - On-the-ground capacity - The capacity of the school determined by the Ministry of Education by loading all instructional spaces within the facility to current Ministry standards for class size requirements and room areas.

**OYAP** - Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program - a school-to-work transition program offered through Ontario secondary schools. Full-time students in Grades 11 and 12 earn cooperative education credits through work placements in skilled trades.

**SHSM** - Specialist High Skills Majors - is a ministry-approved specialized program that allows students to focus their learning on a specific economic sector while meeting the requirements to graduate from secondary school. It also assists in their transition after graduation to apprenticeship training, college, university or the workplace.

**SFIS** - School Facilities Inventory System - A web based system that contains key information on the physical inventory of all school facilities in Ontario.

**Seminar Room** – An instructional space with an area less than 38 M<sup>2</sup>.

**Resource Room** – An instructional space with an area between  $38 \text{ M}^2$  and  $64 \text{ M}^2$  for special education or resource withdrawal.

**TCPS** - Total Capital Planning Solutions - A web based asset management database provided by the Ministry of Education.
