Dear Parents/Guardians:

At its regular meeting on Monday, August 30, 2016, Rainbow District School Board approved accommodation reviews for six planning areas - Central Sudbury, Espanola, New Sudbury, Valley East, Valley North and West Sudbury.

The public will have an opportunity to obtain information and provide input as part of the accommodation review process. There will be a public meeting in each of the planning areas.

The public meeting for the Valley East Planning Area will be held on Thursday, October 27, 2016 from 6 pm to 8:30 pm at Confederation Secondary School, 1918 Main Street, Val Caron. All parents/guardians in the planning area are invited to attend.

Changes in funding from the Ministry of Education have resulted in a significant loss in provincial revenue for Rainbow District School Board. It is essential that we consolidate schools to reduce expenditures.

PROPOSED DELIVERY OF EDUCATION IN VALLEY EAST:

For September 1, 2017:

- Consolidate Grade 7&8 students from Pinecrest Public School into Confederation Secondary School
- Provide JK to Grade 6 at Redwood Acres Public School (currently JK-5)

The Capital and Accommodation Plan Final Staff Report will be presented at a Special Board Meeting on Thursday, November 24, 2016.

A Special Board Meeting will be held on Monday, December 12, 2016 to receive delegations in accordance with the Board's governance by-laws, which can be accessed at http://rainbowschools.ca/board/policies-and-prodecures/delegations

A Special Board Meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 17, 2017 to decide accommodation review outcomes.
