Short Stays

Rainbow International welcomes students who wish to study in Sudbury short-term. Four to twelve week placements are possible for language and cultural immersion. During these educational stays, students will audit classes, receive a cultural education and focus on immersion. Students are expected to attend classes and participate fully in the school and classroom activities. Short stays are four, eight or twelve weeks in length.

Longer Stays

Students can apply for a semester or a full year of study with Rainbow International. As a full-time student, you will receive language development and accumulate credits in a chosen academic pathway.

In order to be considered a full-time student, you must be enrolled in at least three courses per semester. Along with an ESL course each semester, we offer a variety of courses such as:

If you are interested in applying for the IB Program, an academic average of 80% is recommended and an additional application must be completed.
