

Vaccines for teens entering high school

The Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis vaccine is required between 14 and 16 years of age.

Teens are required to receive a booster dose of the Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis vaccine 10 years after their 4- to 6-year-old dose.
