## **RE: CHILDCARE CENTRE CLOSED DUE TO A CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19**

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Rainbow District School Board has been advised by the service provider that a confirmed case of COVID-19 has been reported at the childcare centre at Markstay Public School. Public Health Sudbury & Districts will follow up directly with close contacts. The service provider has indicated that childcare as well as the before and after school programs are ( closed until further notice. (

While the school does not operate the childcare centre, it is an important part of our school ( community. For this reason, we wanted all of our parents/guardians to be informed. ( At this time, there has been no Public Health direction related to the school as a result of the confirmed case at the childcare centre. In an abundance of caution, however, we are ( implementing enhanced cleaning and disinfecting before classes begin on Monday morning. (

We remind parents/guardians to screen their children daily for symptoms of COVID-19. ( Please refer to the school screening tool on the board website – rainbowschools.ca. ( Anyone who is sick must stay home. (

It is also important to continue to follow the COVID-19 prevention measures: (

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Sneeze and cough into your sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Stay home and <u>isolate</u> if symptoms appear.
- Practise two-metre physical distancing.

• Wear a mask in indoor public spaces and outdoors, especially when physical distancing of two metres cannot be maintained.
