C. **PRESENTATIONS**

1. Secondary School Information Nights

Superintendent Noble introduced David Bertrim, Acting Principal of Sudbury Secondary School and Sarah Viljanmaa, Program Leader of Arts Education at Sudbury Secondary School.

David Bertim and Sarah Viljanmaa spoke about the success of Sudbury Secondary School's virtual open house.

The Follow the North Star video was shared with trustees as well as the Meet the Teachers and Alumni prepared videos. These videos can be found on

Sudbury Secondary School's website as well as other information highlighting the uniqueness of Sudbury Secondary School.

Superintendent Noble shared the dates for all secondary school open houses.

Trustees congratulated the presenters on the excellent presentation. Trustees had the opportunity to comment and ask questions.

2. Mental Health Program Update 2021

Superintendent Wachnuk began by highlighting some of the funding that has been provided to support mental health, then introduced Mary Jago, Rainbow's Mental Health Lead.

Mary Jago spoke about the continuum of mental well-being, the allocation of resources (Rainbow's 11 Master Social Workers and two contact Bachelor of Social Worker positions), recreational cannabis and vaping, how Rainbow is part of a growing provincial team, the vision and strategy, additional resources available (through the Offord Ontario Parent Survey, Children's Mental Health Ontario and the Mental Health Commission of Canada), the results of the Ontario Parent Survey, statistics from the Children and Youth Mental Health Survey, RDSB data, trends, the circle of support, how to address the issues and building and sustaining positive mental health. Mary also spoke about some of the positive experiences that have occurred since the beginning of the global pandemic and the importance of self-care and personal resilience for everyone; staff, students and families.

Trustees commented and asked questions. Trustees voiced their appreciation of Mary Jago and all that she does for staff and students at Rainbow DSB.
