## RE: LASALLE SECONDARY SCHOOL CLOSED TO AND INCLUDING MARCH 4

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Public Health Sudbury & Districts has advised Rainbow District School Board that three confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported at Lasalle Secondary School, including the probable case reported on February 21, 2021. The confirmed cases tested positive for a COVID-19 variant of concern.

In an abundance of caution, Public Health has directed that Lasalle Secondary School be closed to and including March 4, 2021. At this time, there is no evidence that the virus was acquired or spread within the school communities, therefore no outbreak has been declared in association with these cases. Public Health continues to investigate and monitor the situation.

Public Health has provided guidance for self-isolation and testing to the cohorts directly impacted as well as the balance of the school population.

The cohorts directly impacted include:

Grade 10 History CHC-2D0-01 Grade 10 English ENG-2D0-03
Grade 12 Canadian Law CLN-4U-01 Grade 12 English ENG-4U-02
Grade 8 A class in Room 209

Details regarding continuation of teaching and learning remotely during the school closure period will be shared as soon as possible. Please do not go to the school to retrieve learning materials or belongings.
