RE: PROBABLE CASE OF COVID-19 AT LASALLE SECONDARY SCHOOL

To Parents/Guardians:

Public Health Sudbury & Districts has advised Rainbow District School Board that a probable case of COVID-19 has been reported at Lasalle Secondary School. The individual is currently self-isolating and being monitored by Public Health Sudbury & Districts while the investigation continues.

Lasalle Secondary School remains open for in-person learners. In an abundance of caution, we are implementing enhanced cleaning and disinfecting before school begins on Monday.

At this time, two classes have been asked to self-isolate until further notice:

Grade 10 History CHC-2D0-01 and Grade 10 English ENG-2D0-03

The affected students, their parents/guardians and relevant staff have been notified and have received a letter from Public Health with specific guidance. Public Health will directly contact all parents/guardians of students and all school personnel who have been identified as **close contacts**. There is no impact on transportation.

For students and staff who have not been asked to self-isolate as part of this probable case, the following applies:

- Simply passing by an infected person in the hallway is not considered close contact, and the risk of spreading the virus this way is extremely low.
- We remind students to screen daily for symptoms of COVID-19 **BEFORE leaving home for school**. Continue to use the COVID-19 screening tool at <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/> to monitor for symptoms and follow the direction provided. Anyone who is sick must stay home. **Students are required to confirm they have completed the screen in first period attendance.**

Remember to follow the critical ongoing COVID-19 prevention measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Sneeze and cough into your sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Stay home and [isolate](#) if symptoms appear.
- Practise two-metre physical distancing.
- Wear a mask in indoor public spaces and outdoors, especially when physical distancing of two meters cannot be maintained.
