

Voter Instructions for Unorganized Localities

Each person on the voters' list shall be mailed, by priority mail a sealed Voter Information Letter containing:

- a. his or her Personal Identification Number (PIN), the telephone number(s) to call to cast a vote, and the designated internet address (URL) to access to cast a vote using the internet;
- b. instructions on how to vote;
- c. dates and hours of voting; and
- d. the telephone number(s) of the Voter Help Contact.

Voter Information Letters shall be bilingually printed in English and French.
