Superintendent Lesley Fisher, Dan Koziar (Principal of Program), Laura Pogue (Elementary Literacy Consultant), Sarah MacDougall and Laura Coleman (Literacy Lighthouse Coaches) presented an overview of the Literacy Lighthouse classes in Rainbow Schools. Currently there are 4 schools hosting the classrooms – Adamsdale Public School, CR Judd Public School, Queen Elizabeth Public School and Redwood Acres Public School.

The goal of the Literacy Lighthouse Initiative is to demonstrate and promote effective classroom literacy instruction so that students experience success earlier and have less need for Tier 2 and 3 interventions.

They shared results of growth with evidence of success across all 4 classes along with videos of students and classrooms in action.
