Team Sudbury Prepares for 2023 Skills Ontario Competition

SUDBURY – Tradestown! Sudbury is a hotbed of skilled trades expertise, and an assembled team of the best and the brightest students focusing on the trades is off to Toronto to represent Sudbury at the annual Skills Ontario competition.

This year's competition is taking place May 1-2, followed by the closing ceremony on May 3.

"Skills Ontario is always an amazing competition and a great opportunity for our team to step up and put their skills to the test," says Renée Scott, Cambrian's Director of Marketing, Recruitment and Student Success. "It's our largest Team Sudbury ever and to see students from high school and college all working together, learning from each other, and cheering each other on, really makes all of us proud. Team Sudbury is made up of 75 students plus their coaches from Cambrian College, the Rainbow District School Board, and the Sudbury Catholic District School Board. It is the fourth time the three institutions have come together as a united northern team at Skills Ontario.

"We extend our best wishes to Team Sudbury as it competes on the provincial stage, including many students from Rainbow Schools who captured top honours at local and regional events," says Bruce Bourget, Director of Education for Rainbow District School Board. "Our students continue to make us proud, demonstrating tremendous ability and creativity in their respective trades. Their success is certainly a tribute to the committed teachers, mentors and partners who inspire them to be their best. Congratulations to all participants."

Since 2018, Team Sudbury has won 22 medals at Skills Ontario including 6 gold, 7 silver 9 bronze.

"Our students continue to excel at Skills Ontario competitions and are eager to participate alongside the other members of Team Sudbury.
